TOPIC: BAKER V. ARGONAUT REVERSED

On June 20, 2002 the Supreme Court reversed the Court of Appeals decision in *Baker v. Argonaut*

The Court of appeals had denied an insurance carrier's right of subrogation for the amount of the policy represented by the self-insured deductible. The Supreme Court has now reversed the Court of Appeals reinstating the carrier's right to recover carrier's full subrogation interest from a claimant's third-party recovery.
